

Pizza Block Quilt

Many layouts and fabric combinations are possible when you create your own pizza using Mary's contemporary pieced block. Have fun learning about dominant and supportive areas and using a design wall. Acrylic templates available. (Foolproof Machine Quilting, p. 34)

Supplies for Pizza Block Quilt:

1. Fabric = three sets, or categories. Plan for at least 9 blocks.

A. Large "show off" triangle: use many 8 1/2" x 6" scraps that follow a theme such as florals, all black dots, large stripes, etc.

B. Background for large triangle: minimum two fat quarters to alternate but may use many 5" x 9" scraps. Needs to be supportive and relate to each other by color or type of fabric (all yellow, all dots, etc.)

C. Two-corner border for triangle block: minimum 2 fat quarters to alternate or may use many 5" x 8" scraps, but must be same type of print such as dots, stripes, or solids.

D. Optional: Possible border fabric and corner fabrics.

2. John Flynn acrylic templates approximately \$11. If you don't wish to purchase, bring ungrided template material.

3. Glue stick, paper, and scissors for one glued mock-up

4. Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler

5. 1 1/2 yds. fabric for design wall

6. Box of pins
