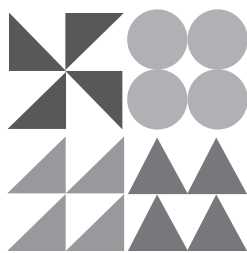

In celebration of the African American Quilt Guild of Oakland's 20th anniversary, members were challenged to create 20"x20" quilts showcasing their mission—preserving quilting traditions while exploring new trends and techniques. AAQGO members represent the diverse cultures, beliefs and values found in the East Bay area. These quilts tell stories of historical events, people, and community. Some dramatize abstract ideas, while others highlight modern quilting trends. Artists used traditional piecing, lettering, appliqué, embellishments, raised figures, and African-American inspired themes to narrate the story of the past 20 years. As they emerge from the pandemic, they look forward to continuing their traditions while promoting fellowship and creativity among their members.

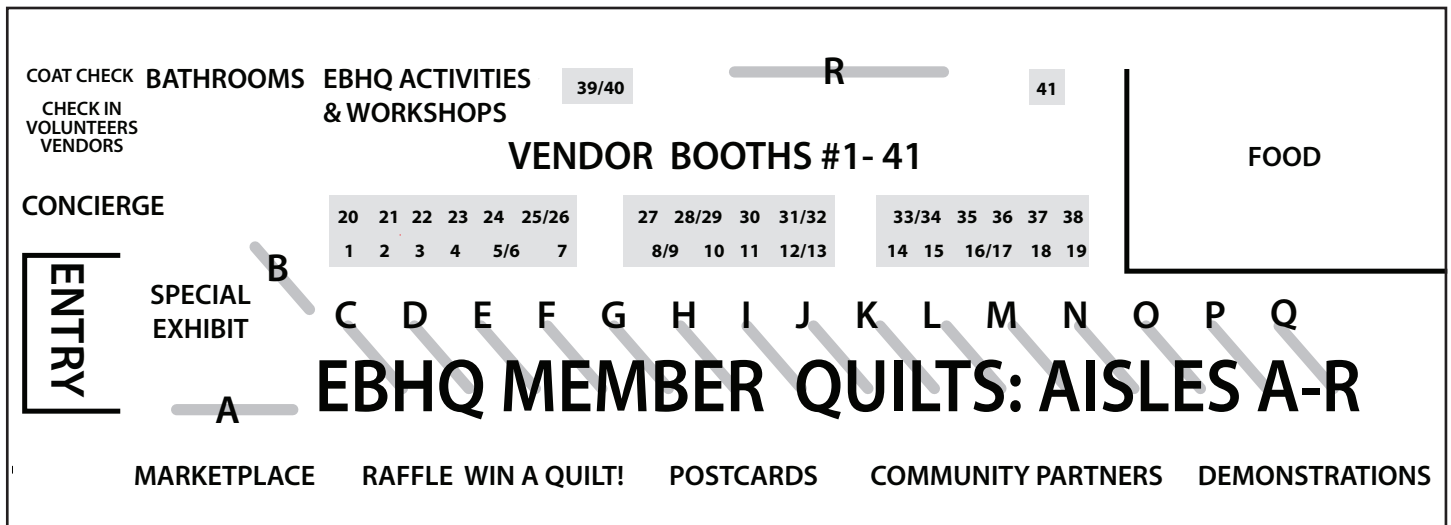
